But in this battle to keep your toddler safe and out of mischief, you’re not alone.

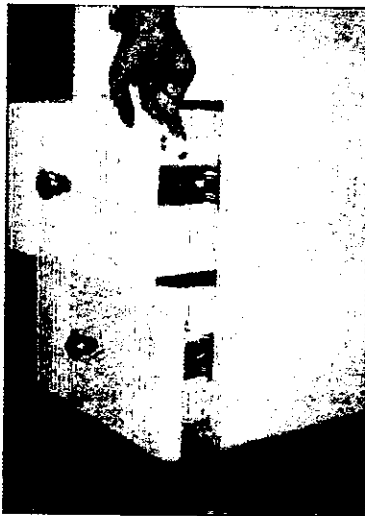

**F149 drawer catches are self-locking and will secure most drawers on metal runners.**



■ **F186 multi-purpose latch** (approx retail \$12.99, pack of three). This flexible latch can be used to secure cabinet doors, drawers, fridges and toilets. It’s easy to install and comes with extra-strong adhesive tape so you just stick it on and is totally clear to suit any decor;

■ **F188 mini multi-purpose latch** (\$9.99, pack of four). A small version of the multi-purpose latch, this is ideal for smaller furniture. It also comes with extra-strong adhesive tape for easy installation;

■ **F103 cabinet sliding lock** (\$3.99).

This is easy to install and doesn’t even need screws. It closes around cabinet handles with a simple sliding action that stops toddlers from opening doors. It’s also adjustable to fit a range of different-sized cabinets;

■ **F106 cabinet flexi-lock** (\$4.99).

This easily installed heart-shaped lock has a dual opening mechanism to make it a real challenge for kids to open;

■ **F101 safety catches** (\$4.99, pack of six). These extra-strong classic drawer catches work well. Once installed, they self-lock every time unless the catch is pressed down;

■ **F187 spring latch value-pack** (\$8.99). These easily installed spring-loaded latches are self-locking. To release, simply push in the cabinet door or drawer slightly while pressing down on the latch;

■ **F147 adhesive double lock** (\$5.99, pack of two). This self-locking safety lock prevents the opening and closing of cabinets and drawers to protect little fingers. To release, just pull the lock down;
